What you can expect

We want to welcome you back to dining-in at the Everett Street Diner. Your safety and the safety of our staff is of the utmost importance to us. We want you to know what we've been doing, and have done to make certain you have an excellent dine-in experience.

Here is what you can expect while dining-in at the Everett Street Diner.

1. Your server/host is wearing a mask and gloves.
2. We ask that you sanitize your hands before you are seated.
3. Tables and chairs have been sanitized prior to you being seated.
4. Your host will now provide your silverware.
5. **For a menu you can scan this QR code or go to everettstreetdiner.com.** The online menu minimizes contact and saves a tree. (One-time use menus available, upon request.)
6. We will take your drink order, and ask about creamers, sugar and sweeteners. Once your food order is taken, we will ask about, and provide, butter, salt, pepper, ketchup, jellies and any other condiments you may need. **Please keep in mind that everything we provide must be disposable so whatever is not used we throw away.** If you need anything additional you may ask any of our servers and they will get it for you promptly.
7. Prior to serving your order the server will put on a fresh set of gloves.
8. To minimize the possibility of any cross contact we will not "pre-bus" any items from your table until you have finished, unless necessary.
9. We are working diligently to balance our capacity restraints, staffing, service and safety. And, of course, we want to maintain the high quality you have come to expect from us.
